**Trail of Tears Commemorative Day**

A day to commemorate and educate the public on the forced removal of the Cherokee Nation from their homelands known today as the Trail of Tears. Exhibits will feature the Trail of Tears and what led up to the sad event, as well as the history of Port Royal and the town's role as the last encampment of the Trail of Tears in Tennessee. There will also be demonstrations of 1830's domestic skills and medicine and interpretive tours through the park. At 10:00 am there will a re-enactment of the march on a section of the original trail with a ceremony immediately following the march.
